Shri Shri 108 Swami Gurdip Ji Maharaj, Gaddi Nashin of Gur Gaddi Swami Jagat Giri Ji Maharaj, Ravidas Chowk, Near New Chakki Bridge, Pathankot, Distt. Gurdaspur aged about 42 years (hereinafter referred to as the Settlor of the First Part)

The Board of Trustees comprising of fourteen members of Dera Swami Jagat Giri Trust as mentioned below thereafter referred to as the Trustees of the Second part)

The name of the Trust shall be Dera Swami Jagat Giri Trust with Regd. Office Guru Ravidass Chowk, Near New Chakki Bridge, Pathankot.

WHEREAS THE SETTLOR is desirous of raising a Non-Profitable, Non-Political, Charitable, Religious & Social Trust for the benefit of the general public, AND WHEREAS THE DONOR has agreed to convey and settle a sum of Rs. 40000/- on the Trust alongwith building of Regd. Office Dera Swami Jagat Giri Trust, registered under Societies Registration Act (XXI of 1960) by Addl. Registrar of Societies cum General Manager, Distt. Industries Centre, Batala (Gurdaspur) vide No. 730 dated 21.09.2001, valuing approx. Rs. 7,45,000/- to be utilised in the best possible manner for the objects and purposes herein after laid down :-

That in pursuance of the objects, the Donor of the Trust as Settlor both hereby convey unto and settle upon the Trustees, the sum of Rs. 40000/- through Cheque No. 763450 dated 17.6.02 drawn on UKD Bank, Pathankot subject to the provisions herein after contained, concerning the same. That the following persons have agreed to become the first Trustees and they are hereby appointed as such :-





#### AIMS & OBJECTS :

1. To spread spiritual awareness in the masses and to educate them for communal / social harmony and Manav Ekta.
2. To educate public for their duty to Samaj i.e. Small family proper education to children and knowledge to the coming generation to adopt the principle of SINCERE TO SENIORS, DEVOTION TO DUTY AND LOYAL TO THE LAND (COUNTRY).

3. To organise Satsangs at Satsang Hall on Chakki Bank, or at any other place as desired by Gaddi Nashin or by Sangat.
4. To organise Samagams / Bhandaras to celebrate the birthdays and Nirwandiwas of Sh. Guru Ravidass and Gurus of this Gur Gaddi.
5. To arrange Parvachans of Saints / Gurus of all sects irrespective of caste and creed, in addition to the Parvachan by the Guru Maharaj of this Guru Gaddi.
6. To celebrate religious functions of all sects to enlighten the public that Manav Samaj is one and there is no high or low in this society.
7. To organise mass marriages by the Trust for the girls and boys of those parents who are economically weak and are unable to solemnise the marriages at their own.
8. To provide means to needy students for obtaining technical, industrial, commercial and Vocational education.
9. To provide free books to needy and poor students.
10. To spend on charitable or religious object or object(s) such as relief to poor, medical relief and the advancement of any object of general public utility & not involving carrying on of any activity for profit or for political purpose.
11. To work for the national integration and defence of the country.
12. To solicit, obtain or accept subscription, donations, grants, gifts, devises, bequests and trusts from any person, firm, corporation or institution including State / Central Govts.
13. To take such steps by personal or written appeals exhibition, public meetings, entertainment, or otherwise as may be deemed expedient for the purpose of the Trust with a view to procure contributions and funds for the Trust in the form of donations, legacies, annual payment or otherwise.
14. To invest and deal with any moneys of the Trust not immediately required for any of its objects in such manner as may be provided by the Constitution of the Trust and as may from time to time be determined.

15. To do all acts, deeds, or things legally admissible as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any or all the objects of the Trust.
16. To provide, establish, endow, maintain, control and manage schools and other educational institutions and to do all acts and things necessary for or conducive to the promotion of schools of the Montessori and Kindergarten type, Primary, Secondary, Higher, Commercial, Professional and Technical at Pathankot and elsewhere and for this purpose, to start, establish, conduct, maintain and manage Reading Rooms, Libraries, Laboratories, Gymnasiums, Hostels, Residential Quarters and the like.
17. To build, construct and maintain houses or other buildings and alter, extend, improve, repair, enlarge or modify the same and to provide and equip the same with light, water, drainage, furniture, fittings, instruments, apparatus and appliances and all other necessaries for the use to which each building is to be put up or held.
18. To construct or otherwise acquire, lay-out, repair, extend, alter, enlarge, improve and use any land, recreation or pleasure-grounds, parks and/or any other immovable property belonging to or held by the Trust.
19. To sell, manage, transfer, exchange, mortgage, demise, dispose of or otherwise deal with any property whatever, belonging to the Trust.
20. To borrow and raise moneys with or without security or on the security of a mortgage, charge or hypothecation or pledge overall or any of the immovable or movable properties belonging to the Trust or in any other manner, whatsoever, in order to attain the Aims & Objects of the Trust.
21. To pay, out of the funds belonging to the Trust or out of any particular part of such funds, all expenses or incidental to the formation of the Trust and management and administration of any of the foregoing objects including all rents, rates, taxes, outgoings and the salaries of the employees.
22. To draw, make, accept, endorse and discount cheques, notes or other negotiable instruments.
23. For the purpose aforesaid, to sign, execute and deliver such assurances and deeds as may be necessary.

24. To amalgamate / affiliate with any other Trust, institution or Association having objects wholly or in part similar to the objects of the Trust.
25. To start or takeover any running school.
26. The income and property of the Trust wheresoever derived shall be applied solely for the promotion of the objects of the Trust as set forth above and no portion thereof shall be paid, transferred directly or indirectly to the members of the Trust by way of dividend, otherwise by way of profit to persons who at any one of them are or any person claiming through all or any of them.
27. No member of the governing body of the Trust shall be appointed to any salaried office of the Trust or paid any fees and that no remuneration shall be given by the Trust to any member of such governing body except repayment of out of pocket expenses and interest on money lent or rent for premises/demised to the Trust.
28. The Trust by its constitution is required to apply its priorities, if any or other income in promoting its objects.
29. If upon the winding up or dissolution of the Trust, there remains after satisfaction of its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed among the members of the Trust, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution having objects similar at or before the time of dissolution.

- a. To provide assistance & relief to the poor.
  - b. To render assistance to persons in distress caused by natural/man made calamities.
  - c. To provide free treatment to deserving patients through Medical Camps, Centers, Hospitals, Mobile Hospitals & Ambulance facilities in emergency.
  - d. To assist local residents of remote/scarce area for maintaining/repair of old Bowries (wells) of Drinking water & setting up of new facilities.

- a. To persuade/motivate uneducated parents to send their children to schools for Education.

- b. To provide free/ subsidised transport facilities to students of distant villages for education.
  - c. To distribute free Books/ Stationery to poor students.
  - d. To award Prizes/ Scholarships to outstanding Students.
  - e. To give Loans/ Scholarships to needy students for education in India/ Abroad.
  - f. To assist/ set up Educational, Vocational, Technical & Professional Institutes.
32. a. To help young men & women in taking Vocational/ Technical Training.
- b. To encourage/ assist unemployed in setting up fair-price shops, cottage industries, Orchards, Nurseries & Farms etc.
  - c. To motivate/ help men & women in achieving betterment/improvement in fields of Agriculture, Science, Engineering, Medicines, Literature, Arts, Music & other public services.
33. a. To take steps to raise status of women & to promote their welfare.
- b. To discourage & fight social evils viz Casteism, Dowry, Mal-treatment to women, Burning of brides etc.
  - c. To set up Centres to impart free Education/ Training to House Wives in Reading, Writing, Sewing, Knitting, Weaving & help them in buying machnies on easy instalments.
34. a. To educate people for Family Welfare, Good Health, Values of Good Citizens & National Character.
- b. To discourage bad habits viz Smoking, Tobacco Chewing, Drinking, Gambling, Lottery & Drug Addiction etc.
35. a. To assist farmers in acquiring know how/ Training for boosting agriculture production, developing new items, protecting crops & grain storage.
- b. To motivate farmers to utilise their waste Garbage by installing Gobar Gas Plants.

- c. To provide free Veterinary Treatment and to educate Cattle owners about the health of their animals.
36. a. To initiate public opinion to have a sympathetic approach towards Orphans, Widows, Destitutes, Handicaps & Aged persons.
- b. To help the Orphans, Widows, Destitutes, Handicaps & Aged in all respects.
37. To co-operate/ assist, other Charitable Trusts; Societies; Institutions, which are wholly or partially engaged in activities designed to promote the Aims & Objectives for which this Trust has been set up.
38. Any person may become the member of the Trust irrespective of Caste and Creed and Religion and can attend the Satsangs and Bhandaras.
39. Any Satsangi can acquire NAM-DAN from the Guru of the Dera Swami Jagat Giri and who satisfies the Guru Maharaj his total faith & devotion in the Derā.
40. For complete dedication and devotion to the Dera and Sat Guru Ravidass Ji Maharaj our worship and paying regards will be by "JAI GURU DEV"

The Nishan Sahib of the Dera / Trust will be " Hari, Chola Majith"

#### BENEFICIARIES :

Beneficiaries shall be all persons without any distinction of Caste, Colour, Creed, Religion, Sex or Age.

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS :

1. That the Trust is authorised to accept contributions/ donation whether in cash or kind, from any member of the public, Trust, association, etc., any State or the Union of India or the Central Government, inclusive of any help or grant or aid from the last mentioned sources, or from any source outside India, in Foreign Exchange. Any contributions, help, grant or aid from any Govt. or Foreign Exchange from any source shall also form part of the Trust Fund.
2. That any property movable or immovable acquired for the purpose of the Trust shall form part of the Trust Fund.

3. That the Board of Trustees are empowered to sell, mortgage or lease any of its properties for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, as well as purchase any other property in place thereof for the promotion of the objects of the Trust.
4. That the Trustees are empowered to file and defend suits or any proceedings in any Court of the Land or Office of the State or Central Government and for that purpose appoint any advocates, fix and pay their fees and such expenses as may be essential and incidental to such proceedings.
5. That the Trustees shall open accounts with one or more scheduled banks in the name of the Trust and keep the liquid funds of the Trust in these bank(s). The bank(s) account shall be operated jointly by any two Trustees to be selected and appointed by the Trust.
6. That the Trustees are empowered to spend the funds of the Trust for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust and it shall be within their discretion to be exercised by majority opinion, as to the amount to be spent on a particular object of the Trust.
7. That the Trust shall maintain regular books of account in which all receipts and expenditure of the Trust shall be recorded. It shall also maintain a record of the meetings of the Trust.
8. That the accounting year of the Trust shall be the Financial year i.e., 1st of April to 31st of March.
9. That the Trust shall have its accounts audited annually by a qualified Chartered Accountant to be appointed by the Trustees on such remuneration as may be agreed upon by the Trustees with the Chartered Accountant. The statement of receipts and expenditure shall be signed by atleast two Trustees and shall be placed before the Board of Trustees at its Annual General meeting and shall be adopted by resolution in that behalf and be kept in a seperate file to be preserved permanently in the office of the Trust.
10. Any vacancy in the Board of Trustees caused due to the death, incapacitation, resignation or for any other reason shall be filled in by the remaining Trustees by majority of votes.

- ii. That the Board of Trustees is hereby empowered to co-opt any person as Trustee, provided however, that the total number of Trustees shall in no case be more 14 (fourteen)
12. Every newly appointed Trustee, in terms of this indenture shall have all the powers and authority of a Trustee under these presents.
13. That the services to be rendered by any Trustee shall be honorary. However, any expenditure incurred by the Trustee for or on behalf of the Trust shall be re-imbursement to him.
14. That the Board of Trustees shall be empowered to engage part time or whole time employees to carry out the work of the Trust and fix the terms of employment including salaries.
15. The meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be called atleast once in six months, the meeting shall be convened by a notice issued by the Chairman.
16. No decision, resolution or act of the Trustees shall become invalid on account of non-participation of any Trustee or on account of any vacancy in the Board of Trustees, not having been filled in.
17. In case a trustee is physically unable to attend a meeting he/she can communicate his/her views in writing to the Chairman and shall be accepted in lieu of his/her attendance.
18. Unless otherwise specified all decisions of the Board of Trustees shall be on the basis of simple majority.
19. Subject to the provisions of this Trust deed, the Board of Trustees may at any time make such rules and regulations for the administration of the Trust as they, in their discretion deem fit and may at any time amend, alter or repeal any of such rules as they think fit. However, such rules and regulations, and their amendments, alterations or repeal thereof should not be repugnant to the objects of the Trust.
20. To make arrangements for the use of any other media-newspaper / magazine or any such organ, or Audio, video, T.V., etc. or any objects of the Trust.
21. To buy, build, repair, hire or rentout any accommodation for the purpose of fulfilment of the aims and objects of the Trust.

22. To help by way of stipend/scholarship/prizes any student research scholar or any other person engaged in any way, for the fulfilment of the purpose of the Trust deemed needy & fit by the Trust.
23. To hold/organise seminars/debates/declamation etc., in keeping with the spirit & objects of the Trust.
24. To raise loan etc., from any financial institution/commercial banks or any other such agency or source for the attainments of the aims of the Trust.
25. To receive royalty of the literature to be published & produced by the Trust through other publishers and grant commission/ discount on the sale of literature, produced by the Trust by itself.
26. The Board of Trustees is empowered to have Patrons and nominate advisors to achieve the aims and objects of the Trust. The Board may also appoint literary Committees/ sub-Committees, Editors/ Editorial Board from among its advisers or otherwise to guide and help the board in various forms of its publications etc.
27. The Trust shall have the power to write off or dispose off through auction, any article-books etc., that has been damaged beyond repairs or has become useless for the Board.
28. The presence of eight members in any formal meeting shall form its Quorum.
29. The Board of Trustees may form Committee / Sub Committees headed by one or more than one members of the Board of Trustee for different purposes like maintenance of Law & Order running of Community Kitchen for Langer, Sewadars (Men & Women). To distinguish the various functionaries may prescribe uniforms etc.
30. Gaddi Nashin of this Gur Gaddi will be Ex-Officio Chairman of the Trust, However in case of any next Guru, the Trust will appoint him Trustee first as per procedure laid down above.

31. In the event of the failure/dissolution of the Trust for any reason, the assets of the Trust shall be transferred to any charitable institution having similar objects for being used for public charitable purposes. In no case any surplus or effect or assets shall be distributed either among the Trustees or the settlor or their heirs.
